## High School Bowling Club State Championships

### Coaches Information

March 2 – 4, 2018 @ Dale's Weston Lanes in Schofield, WI.

**Coaches, please make sure all your bowlers bowling in the state tournament are eligible. This includes making sure you have checked grades. It is suggested that you keep a copy of your bowlers' latest grades with you at state. A few other reminders:**

**Admissions:** \$10 (good for all three days); age 10 and under are free. Wrist bands must be purchased and put on at admissions entry point. Bowlers and spectators will not be admitted without one.

**Bleachers:** Bleachers will be available for spectators. Please keep the area behind the bleachers open per fire codes. Dale's Weston Lanes will not be responsible for injury caused by falls from the bleachers, so please use caution.

**Bowling Balls:** All bowlers are allowed three bowling balls in the bowler area. All extra equipment must remain outside of the bowlers' area in the paddock. Bowlers can use tote bags, but no roller bags.

**Concessions:** Food Concessions will be available throughout the weekend. No alcohol permitted outside of the lounge(s).

**Entry to Building:** Bowlers and coaches please enter the center through the entrance marked for bowlers (East Entrance). Let people at check in know if you're bowling in two events or one team/singles. After you have your wrist band you can enter through main entrance. Two coaches per team and one coach per singles will be allowed to check in. All others must use main entrance to purchase wrist band.

**Finals:** All team and singles semi-finals will be bowled on lanes 37-60. Singles and Team finals on Sunday will be on lanes 1-20.

**Lane Conditions:** Singles, Team, Storm Scholarship Doubles and WI All Star Team Challenge will all be posted on bowlwi.com by Thursday, February 22, 2018 at 4:30 pm.

**Paddock Area:** Located in Mountain Conference Center off the East entrance. BCAW, Dale's Weston Lanes staff and volunteers are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

**Rules:** Visit [www.bowlwi.com](http://www.bowlwi.com) for all state tournament rules located in the Policies and Procedures.

**Shirts/Photos:** ShirtMonster and our official team photographer will be in the meeting rooms. College coaches will be located at tables on the concourse.

**Spectators:** Enter only through main entrance. Doors open: Friday at 2:30pm, Saturday at 7:30am and Sunday at 7:00 am. All BCAW spectator guidelines apply.

**Storm Pro/Classic Products:** Kyle Troup is the Storm touring pro and Doene Moos from Storm will also be on hand. Classic Products, will have PBA pro Steve Jaros and other staff members at the event. Please thank both companies for contributing to the championships.

**Uniform:** No blue jeans allowed for bowlers and coaches. Must wear team shirt and matching pants during the team event. During singles your team shirt is not required but suggested. Coaches don't forget to wear your USBC RVP badge. See page 2 for guidelines.

**Weather:** In the event of inclement weather, we will still hold the event with the participants who are in attendance. If you're not able to make the scheduled squad please call the center at 715-359-8488 and tell an official that you will not be in attendance.

## Uniform Guidelines for Coaches and Bowlers



### TEAMS (Coaches & Bowlers)

**Shirts:** Teams must have the same color and style shirts. No t-shirts allowed. The bowling shirt must have a “butterfly” collar or mock collar with a minimum of  $\frac{3}{4}$  of one inch. All shirts must have finished sleeves for all competition. Females may wear a sleeveless shirt with a butterfly collar only if the sleeves are finished. Shirts with sleeves cut off, torn, or ripped may not be worn. No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted at any time.

**Pants:** Teams must have the same color and style pants. Only full length pants/slacks will be allowed for all males and females during all levels of competition (i.e. qualifying, semifinals, match play). No skirts, skorts, walking shorts, Capri pants, or culottes will be allowed. **No blue jeans are allowed during all singles and team competition.**

All apparel worn by competitors shall be loose fitting and not made of Lycra/spandex-like material.

**Head Covering:** No head covering or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing (hats, caps, or bandannas, etc.). Headphones can only be used in the settee area and cannot be used while bowling.

**Singles Only:** The High School Bowling Club Committee will not require the boys and girls to wear their team shirt during singles competition, but the bowling shirt and pants must adhere to the guidelines above. If a bowler has any question they should ask a tournament official and have their team shirt on hand as a backup shirt.

The Tournament Manager must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. Violating the dress code will result in a disqualification of that individual.

### COACHES

All coaches who will do any coaching in the bowling area must wear their USBC Registered Volunteer ID lanyard or School ID where a background check has been performed. Any coach without their Registered Volunteer ID or School ID or out of uniform will not be allowed in the bowling area.
