



WISCONSIN ADULT-YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

Dress Code – State Finals Tournament

All tournament bowlers must abide by the following dress code rules during the competition. The on-site tournament official, proprietor or other event volunteer will be enforcing the dress code rules. If you think your apparel is questionable, refer it to the on-site tournament official for approval **BEFORE** it is worn. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will require immediate correction to include changing clothes if necessary to be compliant with these rules. An unwillingness or inability to adhere to this dress code will result in disqualification.

- A. All apparel worn by bowlers must be loose fitting and respectable. Torn, holes or extremely baggy clothes will not be allowed. No exposed undergarments will be permitted. Apparel advertising adult products including tobacco and alcohol is not permitted. Profanity and vulgar images are also prohibited. Hats and sunglasses cannot be worn during practice or while competing.
- B. All bowlers will be required to wear slacks, jeans or shorts (must be a suitable length – short shorts will not be permitted) during practice and competition. Ladies/girls may wear capris or skirts/skorts of an appropriate length.
- C. A neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming is required by all competitors.
- D. Any protest of Rules A-C must be addressed and taken care of before start of competition.
- E. Decisions of the on-site tournament official is final.
