<p><b>Algoma Pizza Bowl</b> 401 2nd St., Algoma, WI 920-487-2721</p>	<p>The building with this bowling alley was constructed in 1894 and housed a tavern and hotel until the bowling alley was added in 1946. The pizza oven was installed and the rest is history.</p>
<p><b>Angler's Bar &amp; Grill</b> 10547 Main St, Hayward, WI www.anglersbarandgrill.com 715-634-4700</p>	<p>It is said that during prohibition, played host to the activity of some of America's most notorious gangsters. In 1936, the gas station was remodeled into a bar and bowling alley – which is still present today.</p>
<p><b>Black Earth Lanes</b> 1031 Mills St, Black Earth, WI blackearthlanes.com 608-767-2382</p>	<p>The original four wood lanes were built in 1947 and four more lanes were added in the 1970's. Manual scoring keeps the vintage experience real.</p>
<p><b>Butch &amp; Anne's Pine Grove Lanes</b> W3225 County Rd MM, Elkhart Lake, WI 920-565-3422</p>	
<p><b>Club 53 Bar/Bowling Center</b> 125 Keller Ave N, Amery, WI 715-268-8921</p>	
<p><b>Fort Atkinson Club</b> 211 S Water St E, Fort Atkinson, WI www.fortatkinsonclub.org 920-568-1720</p>	<p>Listed on the National and State Registers of Historic Places, this two wood lane center (with manual pinsetters and scoring!) was originally built in 1912 and lovingly restored in 2017. Call ahead for reservations - private club.</p>
<p><b>Fountain City Village Hall</b> 42 N Main St, Fountain City, WI www.fountaincitywisconsin.com 608-687-7481</p>	<p>Located in the lower level of the city hall and auditorium building, the bowling lanes date back to 1922 and still have manual/human pinsetters! Call ahead for reservations - private facility.</p>

<p><b>Gleason Bowling Center</b> N4878 State Rd 17, Gleason, WI 715-873-4588</p>	
<p><b>Hart's Hooterhaus</b> 205 South St, Hustler, WI 608-427-3444</p>	
<p><b>Holler House</b> 2042 W Lincoln Ave, Milwaukee, WI 414-647-9284</p>	<p>Human pinsetters &amp; manual scoring is a throwback to yesteryear. Holler House has the oldest USBC certified bowling lanes in the world! You do not want to miss this bowling experience.</p>

<p><b>Juneau Lanes</b> 150 E Oak St, Juneau, WI www.juneaulanes.com 920-386-2621</p>	<p>This six lane bowling alley in a building built in the 1890's is our 1st stop and has genuine perfect wooden lanes, old-school overhead projector scoring, above ground ball returns, and the original Brunswick blue colors &amp; gold crown masking units from the 70's.</p>
<p><b>Ley's Bark River Lanes</b> W1914 Main St, Sullivan, WI www.leysbarkriverlanes.com 262-593-2422</p>	<p>Enjoy six wood lanes – manual scoring with paper/pencil.</p>
<p><b>Mally's Spare Time</b> 1681 Day St., Greenleaf, WI 920-864-7822</p>	<p>The building was built around 1925 with four lanes added in 1947. Traditional setters were installed two at a time in 1962 and 1963. The quintessential Wisconsin tavern.</p>
<p><b>Riverview Lanes</b> 634 W Main St, Arcadia, WI riverviewlanesarcadia.com 608-323-7005</p>	<p>Don't let the updated ball returns and scoring fool you. This is a nice vintage era tavern still sporting wood lanes. Bowling here dates back to the pinboy era as evidenced by the wall of signatures by the young men who worked setting pins back in the day.</p>

<p><b>Scott's Rio Lanes</b> 211 Lincoln Ave, Rio, WI 920-992-5225</p>	<p>Built in 1947. This alley has wood lanes with StarShield Masking units. Don't let the autoscoring fool you – this is a quintessential Wisconsin bar with four lanes.</p>
<p><b>Sister Bay Bowl</b> 10640 N Bay Shore Dr, Sister Bay, WI sisterbaybowl.com 920-854-2841</p>	<p>In 1950, the Willems family purchased the Sister Bay Hotel and started welcoming visitors. In 1958, they tore down the dance hall and built a six lane bowling alley.</p>
<p><b>Stars &amp; Strikes</b> 435 W Water St, Princeton, WI 920-295-3333</p>	<p>50's style 4-lane bowling center with manual scoring.</p>
<p><b>Strikes Spares &amp; Spirits</b> 112 Main St., Iron Ridge, WI 920-387-3710</p>	<p>This four wood lanes alley, in a rural farm community, was built over 100 years ago.</p>
<p><b>T &amp; O Bowling Lanes</b> 1007 Oregon St, Oshkosh, WI 920-235-7930</p>	<p>Opened for the 1948-49 bowling season, this classic vintage era bowling alley still depicts a time when bowling thrived with pinboys. While there were nine bowling centers in Oshkosh at that time, T &amp; O Lane is just one of three remaining. The classic wood lanes with over-lane ball returns, star shield masking units and wood benches helps to transport you back to a time when bowling was at its peak.</p>
