RE: COVID-19 Protocols for Regionals

As BCAW and our hosting centers plan for the upcoming WI Pepsi USBC Regional events throughout the state next month, we want to communicate in advance as to the protocols that will be in place for all 16 regional host centers.

The following are the requirements for all locations, without exception:

1. If a bowler or family member has been exposed to COVID-19 or is sick on their scheduled day, please do not come to the bowling center! Please call the center directly to seek possible rescheduling at a later date/time. Refunds will be provided for those who notify the center in advance and are unable to reschedule.
2. In order to provide adequate social distancing on the lanes, only 3 bowlers will be assigned to a lane, and no more than 6 to a pair of lanes.
3. Spectators on the bowling center concourse will be restricted to behind their bowler's assigned lane and limited to 1 person per tournament entrant. We encourage everyone to maintain appropriate social distancing on the concourse and throughout the bowling center while attending this event.
4. Face masks covering the nose and mouth must be worn by all bowlers, spectators and center employees involved in the Pepsi USBC regional event. Bowlers may lower their mask on the approach if they wish, but must pull them back up when stepping off the lane. Bowler and spectator masks may also be lowered when eating or drinking.
