15. B. All girls are eligible whether bowling in the boys or girls division. To qualify for singles: girls fill percentage from both boys and girls division will determine advancing players in the girls singles. Each district will have their team rosters listed on the BCAW scoring website by the start of district competition. Formula used to determine the number of advancing boys and girls will be as follows: District may advance 10% of varsity boys and 10% of the varsity girls or two bowlers per team that advance to state, which ever option allows districts to advance more bowlers to state for singles will be used.

Change Current Policy and Procedure

Formula used to determine number of advancing boys and girls will be as follows: District may advance 10% of varsity boys and 10% of the varsity girls or two bowlers per team that advance to state for singles or all varsity boys with a fill percentage of ~~75%~~ or better and all varsity girls with a fill percentage of ~~75%~~ or better.

75% 84%

Reason for the proposed rule change or new policy & procedure:

This allows the best players in the state to advance. ~~The board may need to adjust the fill percentage based on numbers.~~ The leagues that use a true challenge shot may need to be re-rated like the USBC does with averages to get a fair league fill percentage number. This will get more of the better players at the state tournament and also eliminates the anti team play that puts players against each other on the same team because of the limited number of spots available to advance to state

Another note; Some district bowl as many as 300 frames 66% of the 300 for that district is 198 frames to be eligible. Other districts like D4 only bowl 208 frames, 66% of 208 is 133 frames bowled.

Point System

1. A match point system shall be used to determine conference standings. All bowling will be done on a scratch basis.
2. Districts must schedule and teams bowl nine baker game matches, with the winner of five or more games receiving one point.

Change Current Policy and Procedure

IT WOULD READ AS FOLLOWS: Districts must schedule and teams bowl nine baker game matches, teams will get one point for each game won and one point for total pins.

We would like to see the rule changed to a 10 point system, to many times the final 2 or 3 games mean nothing because the match is already won. I see teams just giving up when they lose the first five or first five out of six. By making it a 10 point system 1 point per game and 1 point for total it keeps teams a better chance to compete

The BCAW High School Committee tweaked the formula in 2017 year to make it simple and consistent. Once the teams are broken down into divisions I and II. The number of teams in each division (by district) is multiplied by .33. The committee rounds up with .5 or greater. For example:

Change Current Policy and Procedure

Once the teams are broken into division I and II. The committee takes the number of teams in each **division** then multiplies by .33 rounds up the .5 or greater to get their numbers. The problem is you take 33 x the number of the teams in your district the number of teams able to be sent to state at times higher than if you use the division numbers

**If you take the number of teams in that district multiplied .33. The committee rounds up with .5. District gets to send whichever is greater. See examples below.**

### Examples

\*A District has 11 teams, based on number of teams in the district x .33 district would get 4 teams  
 $11 \times .33 = 3.63 =$  District would get 4 teams to state after round up

BUT \*District has 11 teams, based on number of teams in the **Division** x .33 district would get 3 to 4 teams

**Division**  
 7-D1 teams x .33 = 2.31 = 2 teams

4-D2 teams x .33 = 1.32 = 1 team

**Division**  
 8-D1 teams x .33 = 2.64 = 3 teams

3-D2 teams x .33 = .99 = 1 team

Each scenario we have 11 teams but get shorted a team in scenario #1 because of your unfair formula

Reason for the proposed rule change or new policy & procedure:

To be sure that district don't get shorted teams to state just because of divisions. The team that get to go would be the next best team in the District and they have to bowl on Friday Night.

District 4 has lost a team each of the last 4 years based on the current rule

**CODIFICATION:**

Action: Review and Discuss

- Codify the singles competition rule indicating the second round scores are combined with the first 3 games for a 6 game total. The only location the 6 game total in determining the finals qualifiers is on the recap.
- Add the term "capris" to the dress code section for girls. This past year a girl wore capris and was on the televised final. There was no clear rule to warrant a challenge.
- Add the verbiage to allow for the bowling center's name to appear on the shirt. A question arose this season and the rule was not clear, but the intent for the center that supports the team to be on the shirt is obvious.
- Include the GPA of 2.0 or school determination is more restrictive be clarified in the Policies and Procedures, as the 2.0 is in the Code of Conduct, but not specified in the P & P.
- Allow for the sponsorship logo/name to be on either sleeve.

## Agenda Item 3

## REDISTRICTING

Action: Review and Discuss/ Action on District 7 Redistricting: Approve or Reject

With the office and center shutdown for nearly 80 days, plans for meeting and discussing redistricting across the state were obviously tabled for 2020-21.

However, due to the immediate need to address the issues in District 7; I had a meeting with 5 leaders from the district representing both factions. The group was composed of Bill Hilbert (DC), Cary Serwe, Dan Schmidt, Gary Hilbert and Tom Zernia. After some background on the state redistricting plans that will be reviewed this season I opened the meeting to discussions and/or concerns for the upcoming season. Within about 5 minutes all parties agreed to divide into District 7a and 7b, using the current north and south boundaries. They understood that there may be additional changes in the future, but felt this Interim step was necessary. Both groups agreed to a 50/50 split of the District's financial assets. Each "new" district will meet with their respective groups to set up the needed officers, bylaws and bank accounts. I indicated they should hold off on any action until after the High School Committee reviewed the proposal and took action. COMMITTEE DECISION: Approve or Reject.

## Discussion of Statewide Redistricting:

Pete and I met recently to discuss the truncate timeline for state redistricting and came to the conclusion that action should be delayed to the 2021-22 season. However, now is the time to start reviewing the issues and developing various plans and gathering feedback so announcements could be decided by the first of the year. This would allow districts to start the realignment process while still engaged in this season. Pete will discuss how he would like to organize the process between committee, volunteers and staff.
